Consideration, discussion, and possible Board action on a Resolution for the purpose of providing ambulance services to all county residents by providing for the continuing levy and assessment of a one-fourth of one percent (1/4 of 1%) county excise (sales) tax upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales taxable under the Oklahoma sales tax code including but not limited to certain enumerated sales listed therein prescribing the effective dates and duration of the tax; prescribing the purposes for each such tax; requiring voting at an election held for such purpose as provided by law; providing exemptions from said tax; providing for the administration and collection of said tax; providing for interest and penalties for failure to pay tax when due; authorizing the Board of County Commissioners to make administrative and technical changes and additions except of tax rate; and providing severability of provisions; requiring approval of such tax by a majority of the registered voters voting at an election held for such purpose as provided by law; and fixing the effective date.
15. Consideration, discussion, and possible Board action on a Resolution for the purpose of providing ambulance services to all county residents by providing for the continuation of a special annual recurring ad valorem tax of one (1) mill on the dollar of assessed valuation being levied, in addition to all other levies, upon the assessed valuation of all taxable property in Noble County, Oklahoma, real and personal, under the authority of Article 10, Section 9C of the Oklahoma Constitution, as amended, effective in the 2027 tax year and thereafter for the term of ten (10) years, with the proceeds of such tax levy to be allocated to the existing ambulance service providers furnishing ambulance services in Noble County, and their successors, in the same percentage as the number of persons residing in each area within the ambulance service district served by each ambulance provider (in accordance with each successive federal decennial census) and with ten percent (10%) of the annual tax proceeds reserved and expended for all lawful purposes of an emergency medical service district and its purpose of providing ambulance services and emergency medical first responder services to all county residents and requiring approval of such tax by a majority of the registered voters voting at an election held for such purpose as provided by law, however voter approval of this resolution shall be dependent upon voter approval and passage of proposition 2 which pertains directly to Resolution No. 2026-___ of the County Commissioners of Noble County, Oklahoma.

Consideration, discussion, and possible Board action on a Notice of Election on the two (2) propositions set forth therein with Proposition I pertaining to the continued levy of a special annual recurring Ad Valorem tax of one (1) mill on the dollar of assessed valuation effective for the 2027 tax year and continuing thereafter for a term of ten (10) years; and Proposition II pertaining to the continued levy and assessment of a County Excise Tax (Sales Tax) of one-fourth of one percent (1/4 of 1%) ; and both Propositions providing for the purpose and allocation of funds derived from said taxes.
